

Sub: MEASURES FOR CURBING THE MENACE OF RAGGING IN EDUCATIONAL INSTITUTIONS – IMPLEMENTATION OF DIRECTIONS OF HON'BLE SUPREME COURT OF INDIA - information as per section 12.2 of DCI Regulations on Curbing the Menace of Ragging in Dental Colleges, 2009 to be uploaded on DCI website within 15 days after opening of lockdown by the respective State/UT/District – Regarding.

Sir/Madam,

I am directed to say that as per DCI Regulations on Curbing the Menace of Ragging in Dental Colleges, 2009, it is the responsibility of all the institution to ensure that no incident of ragging takes place in their dental institution and measures taken to curb it may be reviewed.

- As per section 11.3 of the aforesaid regulations, the authorities/Management (Trust, Societies, etc.) of the institution, particularly the Head of the institution, shall be responsible to ensure that no incident of ragging takes place in the institution. In case, any incident of ragging takes place, the Management/Head shall take prompt and appropriate action against the person(s) whose dereliction of duty lead to the incident. The authority designated to appoint the Head shall, in its turn, take prompt and appropriate action against the head.
- All dental institutions should issue advertisements against ragging through signboards, pamphlets etc. before the commencement of academic year as well as during the midst of the session. You are also requested to issue booklets to all the students of your Institutions containing the details about what constitutes ragging, punishable ingredients of ragging, punishments and penalty for ragging, names and mobile numbers of the members of the Anti Ragging Squad, Anti Ragging Committee (Anti Ragging Helpline), Wardens, Deputy Wardens of Men's and Women's hostel including maintaining social distancing as precautionary measure.
- All dental Institutions shall designate any of their faculty member(s) as "Counsellor" for fresher and senior students to co-ordinate the batches of students (Counselees) regularly about day-to-day problems and also to sensitize their role in curbing the menace of ragging.
- You are further requested to obtain and file undertaking, on anti ragging, from all parents/guardians and students (1st year to final year) studying in BDS/MDS/PG Diploma/Para Dental Courses or any other course approved/recognised by DCI, online through www.antiragging.in / www.amanmovement.org.
- Besides above, it is also pertinent to mentioned here that, as per section 12.2 of subject regulations, each and every institution shall submit its reports in prescribed format (Annexure-II) to the Secretary, Dental Council of India, Aiwan-E-Galib Marg, Kotla Road, New Delhi-110002, by 30th April of every year in respect of the previous academic session, indicating the requisite information against each column thereof, failing which the Dental Council of India, as per section 11.4 of Regulations on Curbing the Menace of Ragging in Dental Colleges, 2009, shall impose any one or any combination of the following penalties on it:-

- 11.4.1 To initiate the derecognition process against the institution under section 16A of the Dentists Act, 1948.
- 11.4.2 To reduce the admission capacity of the institution to the extent to which the Council deem fit.
- 11.4.3 To stop further admission in the institution till further orders.
- 11.4.4 To stop renewal of permission in respect of UG/PG Dental Courses.
- 11.4.6 To post the information regarding penalties so imposed on the concerned institution on the website of DCI for information of all concerned.


7. The DCI has developed an online module and necessary directions have already been given to all dental colleges to upload the requisite information / documents on DCI website instead of forwarding above documents to reduce the paper work and to scrutiny the above data efficiently, accordingly, any hard copy of information /documents received by Post or sent by E-mail shall NOT be considered by DCI.

8. Since due to outbreak of COVID-19, the dental colleges may not be in a position to upload its requisite details on the website of this Council under Regulation 12.2 before 30.04.2020. Therefore, the Executive Committee of the DCI in its meeting held on 29.04.2020 has decided to extend the date to upload the requisite information within 15 days from the date of opening of lockdown in the respective State/UT/District.

9. In view of the above, I am directed to request you that the requisite information for the previous academic session 2019-2020 may kindly be uploaded on DCI website within 15 days of the opening of lockdown in the respective State/UT/District, positively, as the said information is required to be sent to the Monitoring Committee appointed by the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India. In case the information is not uploaded within abovementioned duration, the name of defaulting institution will be forwarded to the said Monitoring Committee for such appropriate action as may be deemed fit and proper by the said Hon'ble Monitoring Committee, and their names will also be uploaded on DCI Website.

10. This may kindly be treated as 'Most Urgent'.

11. The Dental Council of India ensures Zero Tolerance against ragging of any sort.

You are also requested to furnish the CD/Photographs of the Workshop /Seminar /Conference to be conducted by your Dental College and also furnish the list of participants of the above Workshop /Seminar /Conference to DCI, by 15th November 2019 positively, for furtherance in the matter.

Sir/Madam,

I am directed to say that as per DCI Regulations on Curbing the Menace of Ragging in Dental Colleges, 2009, it is the responsibility of all the institution to ensure that no incident of ragging takes place in their dental institution and measures taken to curb it may be reviewed.

- As per section 11.3 of the aforesaid regulations, the authorities/Management (Trust, Societies, etc.) of the institution, particularly the Head of the institution, shall be responsible to ensure that no incident of ragging takes place in the institution. In case any incident of ragging takes place, the Management/Head shall take prompt and appropriate action against the person(s) whose dereliction of duty lead to the incident. The authority designated to appoint the Head shall, in its turn, take prompt and appropriate action against the head.
- All dental institutions should issue advertisements against ragging through signboards, pamphlets etc. before the commencement of academic year as well as during the midst of the session. You are also requested to issue booklets to all the students of your Institutions containing the details about what constitutes ragging, punishable ingredients of ragging, punishments and penalty for ragging, names and mobile numbers of the members of the Anti Ragging Squad, Anti Ragging Committee (Anti Ragging Helpline), Wardens, Deputy Wardens of Men's and Women's hostel.
- All dental Institutions shall designate any of their faculty member(s) as "Counsellor" for fresher and senior students to co-ordinate the batches of students (Counselees) regularly about day-to-day problems and also to sensitize their role in curbing the menace of ragging.
- You are further requested to obtain and file undertaking, on anti ragging, from all parents/guardians and students (1st year to final year) studying in BDS/MDS/PG Diploma/Para Dental Courses or any other course approved/recognised by DCI, online through www.antiragging.in / www.amanmovement.org.
- Besides above, it is also pertinent to mentioned here that, as per section 12.1 of subject regulations, each and every institution shall submit its reports in prescribed format (Annexure-II) to the Secretary, Dental Council of India, Ajwan-E-Gallb Marg, Kotla Road, New Delhi-110002, by 31st October of every year in respect of the previous academic session, indicating the requisite information against each column thereof, failing which the Dental Council of India, as per section 11.4 of Regulations on Curbing the Menace of Ragging in Dental Colleges, 2009, shall impose any one or any combination of the following penalties on it:-

- 11.4.1 To initiate the derecognition process against the institution under section 16A of the Dentists Act, 1948.
- 11.4.2 To reduce the ad'mission capacity of the institution to the extent to which the Council deem fit.
- 11.4.3 To stop further admission in the institution till further orders.
- 11.4.4 To stop renewal of permission in respect of UG/PG Dental Courses.
- 11.4.6 To post the information regarding penalties so imposed on the concerned institution on the website of DCI for information of all concerned.

7. Further, it is also to inform you that the DCI has developed an online module to upload the requisite information / documents on DCI website to reduce the paper work and to scrutiny the above data efficiently, accordingly, the Executive Committee of the DCI in its meeting held on 13.10.2018 at New Delhi has decided that the all the requisite information / documents required as per DCI Regulations on Curbing the Menace of Ragging in Dental Colleges, 2009, shall be uploaded on DCI website and any hard copy of information /documents received by Post or sent by E-mail shall not be considered by DCI.

8. In view of the above, I am directed to request you that the requisite information in the prescribed format (Annexure-II as prescribed in DCI Regulations) for the academic session 2019-2020 may kindly be uploaded on DCI website by 31.10.2019, positively, as the said information is required to be uploaded as per request of the Monitoring Committee appointed by the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India. In case the information is not uploaded by 31.10.2019 on DCI website, the name of defaulting institution will be forwarded to the said Monitoring Committee for such appropriate action as may be deemed fit and proper by the said Hon'ble Monitoring Committee, and their names will also be uploaded on DCI Website.

9. This may kindly be treated as 'Most Urgent'.

10. The Dental Council of India ensures Zero Tolerance against ragging of any sort.

महोदय,

मुझे यह कहने का निदेश हुआ है कि डीसीआई विनियम के मुताबिक, दंत चिकित्सा महाविद्यालयों में रेगिंग की बुराई पर रोक लगाने के लिए सभी दन्त संस्थानों की यह जिम्मेदारी है कि वे यह सुनिश्चित करें कि उनके दंत संस्थान में रेगिंग की कोई घटना न हो और इसे रोकने के लिए किए गए उपायों की समीक्षा की जाए।

2. उपर्युक्त नियमों की धारा 11.3 के अनुसार, संस्थान के प्राधिकारी / प्रबंधक वर्ग (ट्रस्ट, सोसाइटी आदि), विशेष रूप से संस्थान का अध्यक्ष यह सुनिश्चित करने के लिए जिम्मेदार होगा कि संस्थान में रेगिंग की कोई घटना न हो। यदि रेगिंग की कोई घटना घटती है तो वह प्रबंधक वर्ग / अध्यक्ष ऐसे व्यक्ति / व्यक्तियों के विरुद्ध तत्काल और उपयुक्त कार्रवाई करेगा जिनके कर्तव्य की तापरवाही से यह घटना हुई। तदनंतर अध्यक्ष को नियुक्त करने वाला पदनामित अधिकारी अध्यक्ष के विरुद्ध तत्काल और उपयुक्त कार्रवाई करेगा।

3. सभी दंत संस्थानों को अकादमिक वर्ष के आरंभ होने के साथ-साथ सत्र के दौरान भी साइनबोर्ड, पुस्तिका आदि के माध्यम से रेगिंग रोकने के लिए विज्ञापन देना चाहिए। आपसे अनुरोध किया जाता है कि अपने संस्थान के सभी छात्रों को पुस्तिकाएं जारी करें, जिसमें विवरण हो कि रेगिंग क्या है, रेगिंग की दंडनीय गतिविधियां, रेगिंग करने पर दंड व जुर्माना और रेगिंग विरोधी दस्तों के सदस्यों (एंटी रेगिंग कमेटी और एंटी रेगिंग हैल्पलाइन), पुरुष व महिला होस्टल वार्डन्स / डिप्टी वार्डन्स आदि के नाम और मोबाइल नंबर।

4. सभी दंत संस्थान अपने किसी भी संकाय सदस्य (सदस्यों) को नये और वरिष्ठ छात्रों के लिए "सलाहकार" के रूप में नामित करें, जो दिन-प्रतिदिन की समस्याओं के बारे में नियमित रूप से विद्यार्थियों (काउन्सेलर्स) के दल को समन्वयित करने तथा रेगिंग की बुराई को रोकने में उनकी भूमिका को संवेदित करने के लिए निर्दिष्ट करते रहे।

5. आपसे यह भी अनुरोध किया जाता है कि आप बीडीएस / एमडीएस / पीजी डिप्लोमा / पैरा डेंटल पाठ्यक्रम या डीसीआई द्वारा मान्यता प्राप्त किसी भी अन्य पाठ्यक्रम में पढ़ाई करने वाले सभी छात्रों (प्रथम वर्ष से अंतिम वर्ष) और उनके माता-पिता / अभिभावकों से रेगिंग विरोधी होने का वचन पत्र प्राप्त करके (ऑनलाइन के माध्यम www.antiragging.in / www.amanmovement.org से) जमा करें।

6. उपर्युक्त के अलावा यह भी उल्लेखनीय है कि रेगिंग की बुराई पर रोक लगाने वाले डीसीआई विनियम के खंड 12.1 के अनुसार प्रत्येक दंत संस्थान को पिछले शैक्षणिक सत्र के संबंध में अपेक्षित जानकारी (संलग्नक-II के निर्धारित प्रारूप में) अपनी रिपोर्ट सचिव, भारतीय दंत परिषद, ऐवान-ए-गालिब मार्ग, कोटला रोड, नई दिल्ली - 110002 को, प्रत्येक वर्ष 31 अक्टूबर, तक प्रस्तुत करना है अन्यथा भारतीय दंत परिषद दन्त कॉलेजों में रेगिंग की बुराई पर रोक लगाने वाले डीसीआई विनियम, 2009 के खंड 11.4 के अनुसार निम्नलिखित दंड के किसी एक या किसी भी संयोजन को लागू करेगा:

- 11.4.1 दंत्य चिकित्सा अधिनियम, 1948 के खंड 16ए के अधीन संस्थान के विरुद्ध मान्यता समाप्त करने की कार्रवाई शुरू करना।
- 11.4.2 संस्थान की दाखिला क्षमता में उतनी कमी करना जितना परिषद उचित समझे।

- 11.4.4 यूजी/पीजी दंत्य पाठ्यक्रमों के संबंध में अनुमति का नवीकरण बंद करना।
- 11.4.5 संबंधित संस्थान पर इस तरह लगाए गए दंडों से संबंधित सूचना सभी संबंधितों की जानकारी के लिए डीसीआई के वेबसाइट पर प्रस्तुत करना।

CIRCULAR

The undersigned has been directed to bring to the notice of the Principal/Head of all dental colleges of the country that the University Grants Commission vide its D.O. No.1-15/2009 (ARC) pt.III dated 27.06.2019, in order to ensure a ragging free campus, has made the following recommendations and action steps to be deployed at all the institutions including dental colleges:-

A. Basic Measures:

1. Constitution of anti-ragging committee, anti-ragging squad, setting up of Anti-Ragging Cell and Adequate publicity for these measures through various media are to be undertaken.
2. Mention of anti-ragging warning in the institution's prospectus and information booklets/brochures shall be ensured.
3. Updating websites of institutions with the complete address and contact details of nodal officers related to anti-ragging committee.
4. In compliance with the UGC Regulations and its 2nd Amendment regarding submission of undertaking by each student and every parent, an online undertaking in every academic year to be submitted.
5. UGC has notified 3rd Amendment in UGC Regulations on 29th June, 2016 to expand the definition of ragging by including the following:

"3. (i) Any act of physical or mental abuse (including bullying and exclusion) targeted at another student (fresher or otherwise) on the ground of colour, race, religion, caste, ethnicity, gender (including transgender), sexual orientation, appearance, nationality,


D. Using other UGC initiated measures

1. Students in distress due to ragging related incidents can call the National Anti-Ragging Helpline 1800-180-5522 (24x7 Toll Free) or e-mail the Anti-Ragging Helpline at helpline@antiragging.in.
2. For any other information regarding ragging, please visit the UGC website i.e. www.ugc.ac.in & www.antiragging.in and contact UGC monitoring agency i.e. Aman Satya Kachroo Trust on mobile No. 09871170303, 9818400116 (only in case of emergency).
1. UGC also drives an Anti-Ragging Media Campaign through different modes and UGC has got developed the following entities to promote anti-ragging which are available on UGC website i.e. www.ugc.ac.in.
 - a. UGC has developed 05 TVCs of 30 seconds each from different perspective i.e. parents, Victim and Offenders.
 - b. UGC has designed and distributed posters amongst Universities/Regulatory Authorities/ Councils/IITs/NITs/Other educational institutions for the prominent display.
 - c. UGC has consecutively organized 02 Anti-Ragging Competitions for students/faculty /general public for the wider awareness of the menace of ragging.

Besides, each and every dental institution shall be statutorily obliged to conduct an Anti-Ragging workshop immediately after the admission process at both UG and PG level and all UG / PG students of the college and all member of the Anti-ragging committee shall attend such workshop. Further, Anti-ragging workshop shall not be included with any other conference / programme and activities of the college.

Accordingly, each and every dental institutions including your dental college are requested to implement the recommendations contained in their earlier communication of even number dated 27.12.2018 so as to ensure a ragging-free campus, a fundamental requirement for a supportive and fair institutional climate which is open to change, learning and progress.



क. मूलभूत उपाय:

1. रैगिंग रोधी समितियों, रैगिंग रोधी दस्तों का गठन, रैगिंग रोधी प्रकोष्ठ की स्थापना और विभिन्न मीडिया के माध्यम से इन उपायों का पर्याप्त प्रचार किया जाए।
2. संस्थान की विवरणिका और सूचना पुस्तिकाओं / ब्रोशर में रैगिंग रोधी चेतावनी का उल्लेख सुनिश्चित किया जाएगा।
3. रैगिंग रोधी समिति से संबंधित नोटल अधिकारियों के पूर्ण पते और संपर्क संबंधी ब्योरे के साथ संस्थानों की वेबसाइट अद्यतन करना।



Sir,

I am directed to refer to the subject cited above and to say that the last date upto which the students can be joined in BDS Course is **15th September, 2019** as per Time Schedule for completion of admission process for first BDS Course for the academic session 2019-20 as prescribed in "Dental Council of India (Establishment of New Dental Colleges, Opening of New or Higher Course of study or Training and Increase of Admission Capacity in Dental Colleges) (13th Amendment) Regulations, 2018".

2. Accordingly, the college authorities of all dental colleges are hereby directed to upload the details of students, admitted in BDS Course at their dental institution for the academic session **2019-2020**, on DCI Website, using their already allotted login credentials, on or before the last date of admission i.e. **15th September, 2019**, positively, failing which it shall be presumed that the college authorities have not admitted any student in BDS Course at their college for the academic session 2019-20 and if the college authorities claims any admission after the cut-off date, then Section 10B of the Dentists (Amendment) Act, 1993 and Section 16A of the Dentists Act, 1948 shall be attracted.

3. Since, as per Section 10D of the Dentists (Amendment) Act, 2016, all admissions in BDS Course shall only be made through National Eligibility-cum-Entrance Test (NEET), the DCI has developed the online module for entry of students details in such a way that the college authorities can upload the details of students by searching students NEET roll number only so as to enable them to upload all details of students correctly in very less time.

4. It is also to inform you that only uploaded details of students on DCI Website shall be considered and any details of students received in any other format viz. e-mail or hard copy shall not be considered at all, therefore, you are requested not to send the subject details through e-mail or post. It is also stated that no request for extension of time to upload the above details of students or any other excuse or reason of technical fault, etc. shall be considered, therefore, you are requested to ensure and make available all arrangements at your end to complete the above task, in time, so as to avoid any litigation and to enable this Council to take necessary action in a time bound manner.

5. In case, any admission(s) is/are made in violation of Revised BDS Course Regulations, 2007 as amended from time to time or the Time Schedule for the academic session 2019-20 or non compliance of above any direction for uploading the details of the students on DCI website or in violation of the provisions of the Dentists Act and Regulations made thereunder, the college authorities shall be liable to discharge such students failing which the provisions of the Section 10B of the Dentists (Amendment) Act, 1993 providing for non-recognition of dental qualification in respect of such students or / and the provisions of Section 16A for withdrawal of recognition for violation of conditions of admissions, as the case may be, would be initiated against such erring dental college(s).



Sir,

I am directed to say that as per DCI Regulations on Curbing the Menace of Ragging in Dental Colleges, 2009, ragging is a criminal offence and UGC has framed Regulations on Curbing the Menace of Ragging in Higher Educational Institutions in order to prohibit, prevent and eliminate the scourge of ragging. These Regulations are mandatory and all institutions are required to take necessary steps for its implementation in toto including the monitoring mechanism as per provisions in the above Regulations and ensure its strict compliance. Any violation of DCI Regulations as cited above or if any institution fails to take adequate steps to prevent ragging or does not act in accordance with these Regulations or fails to punish perpetrators of incidents of ragging suitably will attract action under the DCI Regulations.

2. The UGC has developed 4 short films and a documentary film to counsel students on ill effects of ragging. These films are uploaded on UGC website and DCI website.

3. You are requested to show these TVCs, short films and jingles, regularly to all the students and other staff during orientation and other programmes. These movies are available on the following links:-



Sub: MEASURES FOR CURBING THE MENACE OF RAGGING IN EDUCATIONAL INSTITUTIONS - IMPLEMENTATION OF DIRECTIONS OF HON'BLE SUPREME COURT OF INDIA - information as per section 12.1 of DCI Regulations on Curbing the Menace of Ragging in Dental Colleges, 2009 to be uploaded on DCI website by 31.10.2019 - Regarding.

Sir/Madam,

I am directed to say that as per DCI Regulations on Curbing the Menace of Ragging in Dental Colleges, 2009, it is the responsibility of all the institution to ensure that no incident of ragging takes place in their dental institution and measures taken to curb it may be reviewed.

2. As per section 11.3 of the aforesaid regulations, the authorities/Management (Trust, Societies, etc.) of the institution, particularly the Head of the institution, shall be responsible to ensure that no incident of ragging takes place in the institution. In case any incident of ragging takes place, the Management/Head shall take prompt and appropriate action against the person(s) whose dereliction of duty lead to the incident. The authority designated to appoint the Head shall, in its turn, take prompt and appropriate action against the head.
3. All dental institutions should issue advertisements against ragging through signboards, pamphlets etc. before the commencement of academic year as well as during the midst of the session. You are also requested to issue booklets to all the students of your Institutions containing the details about what constitutes ragging, punishable ingredients of ragging, punishments and penalty for ragging, names and mobile numbers of the members of the Anti Ragging Squad, Anti Ragging Committee (Anti Ragging Helpline), Wardens, Deputy Wardens of Men's and Women's hostel.
4. All dental Institutions shall designate any of their faculty member(s) as "Counsellor" for fresher and senior students to co-ordinate the batches of students (Counselees) regularly about day-to-day problems and also to sensitize their role in curbing the menace of ragging.
5. You are further requested to obtain and file undertaking, on anti ragging, from all parents/guardians and students (1st year to final year) studying in BDS/MDS/PG Diploma/Para Dental Courses or any other course approved/recognised by DCI, online through www.antiragging.in / www.amanmovement.org.
6. Besides above, it is also pertinent to mentioned here that, as per section 12.1 of subject regulations, each and every institution shall submit its reports in prescribed format (Annexure-II) to the Secretary, Dental Council of India, Aiwan-E-Galib Marg, Kotla Road, New Delhi-110002, by 31st October of every year in respect of the previous academic session, indicating the requisite information against each column thereof, failing which the Dental Council of India, as per section 11.4 of Regulations on Curbing the Menace of Ragging in Dental Colleges, 2009, shall impose any one or any combination of the following penalties on it:-

- 11.4.1 To initiate the derecognition process against the institution under section 16A of the Dentists Act, 1948.
- 11.4.2 To reduce the admission capacity of the institution to the extent to which the Council deem fit.
- 11.4.3 To stop further admission in the institution till further orders.
- 11.4.4 To stop renewal of permission in respect of UG/PG Dental Courses.
- 11.4.6 To post the information regarding penalties so imposed on the concerned institution on the website of DCI for information of all concerned.


7. Further, it is also to inform you that the DCI has developed an online module to upload the requisite information / documents on DCI website to reduce the paper work and to scrutiny the above data efficiently, accordingly, the Executive Committee of the DCI in its meeting held on 13.10.2018 at New Delhi has decided that the all the requisite information / documents required as per DCI Regulations on Curbing the Menace of Ragging in Dental Colleges, 2009, shall be uploaded on DCI website and any hard copy of information /documents received by Post or sent by E-mail shall not be considered by DCI.

8. In view of the above, I am directed to request you that the requisite information in the prescribed format (Annexure-II as prescribed in DCI Regulations) for the academic session 2019-2020 may kindly be uploaded on DCI website by 31.10.2019, positively, as the said information is required to be uploaded as per request of the Monitoring Committee appointed by the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India. In case the information is not uploaded by 31.10.2019 on DCI website, the name of defaulting institution will be forwarded to the said Monitoring Committee for such appropriate action as may be deemed fit and proper by the said Hon'ble Monitoring Committee, and their names will also be uploaded on DCI Website.

महोदय,

मुझे यह कहने का निदेश हुआ है कि डीसीआई विनियम के मुताबिक, दंत चिकित्सा महाविद्यालयों में रैगिंग की बुराई पर रोक लगाने के लिए सभी दन्त संस्थानों की यह जिम्मेदारी है कि वे यह सुनिश्चित करें कि उनके दंत संस्थान में रैगिंग की कोई घटना न हो और इसे रोकने के लिए किए गए उपायों की समीक्षा की जाए।

2. उपर्युक्त नियमों की धारा 11.3 के अनुसार, संस्थान के प्राधिकारी / प्रबंधक वर्ग (ट्रस्ट, सोसाइटी आदि) विशेष रूप से संस्थान का अध्यक्ष यह सुनिश्चित करने के लिए जिम्मेदार होगा कि संस्थान में रैगिंग की कोई घटना न हो। यदि रैगिंग की कोई घटना घटती है तो वह प्रबंधक वर्ग / अध्यक्ष ऐसे व्यक्ति / व्यक्तियों के विरुद्ध तत्काल और उपयुक्त कार्रवाई करेगा जिनके कर्तव्य की लापरवाही से यह घटना हुई। तदनंतर अध्यक्ष को नियुक्त करने वाला पदनामित अधिकारी अध्यक्ष के विरुद्ध तत्काल और उपयुक्त कार्रवाई करेगा।

3. सभी दंत संस्थानों को अकादमिक वर्ष के आरंभ होने के साथ-साथ सत्र के दौरान भी साइनबोर्ड, पुस्तिका आदि के माध्यम से रैगिंग रोकने के लिए विज्ञापन देना चाहिए। आपसे अनुरोध किया जाता है कि अपने संस्थान के सभी छात्रों को पुस्तिकाएं जारी करें, जिसमें विवरण हो कि रैगिंग क्या है, रैगिंग की दंडनीय गतिविधियां, रैगिंग करने पर दंड व जुर्माना और रैगिंग विरोधी दस्ते के सदस्यों (एंटी रैगिंग कमेटी और एंटी रैगिंग हैल्पलाइन), पुरुष व महिला होस्टल वार्डन्स / डिप्टी वार्डन्स आदि के नाम और मोबाइल नंबर।

4. सभी दंत संस्थान अपने किसी भी संकाय सदस्य (सदस्यों) को नये और वरिष्ठ छात्रों के लिए "सलाहकार" के रूप में नामित करें, जो दिन-प्रतिदिन की समस्याओं के बारे में नियमित रूप से विद्यार्थियों (काउन्सेलिस) के दल को समन्वयित करने तथा रैगिंग की बुराई को रोकने में उनकी भूमिका को संवेदित करने के लिए निर्दिष्ट करते रहे।

5. आपसे यह भी अनुरोध किया जाता है कि आप बीडीएस / एमडीएस / पीजी डिप्लोमा / पैरा डेंटल पाठ्यक्रम या डीसीआई द्वारा मान्यता प्राप्त किसी भी अन्य पाठ्यक्रम में पढ़ाई करने वाले सभी छात्रों (प्रथम वर्ष से अंतिम वर्ष) और उनके माता-पिता / अभिभावकों से रैगिंग विरोधी होने का वचन पत्र प्राप्त करके (ऑनलाइन के माध्यम www.antiragging.in / www.amanmovement.org से) जमा करें।





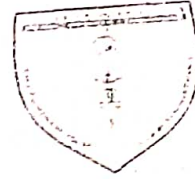

Sir/Madam,

I am directed to say that as per DCI Regulations on Curbing the Menace of Ragging in Dental Colleges, 2009. it is the responsibility of all the institution to ensure that no incident of ragging takes place in their dental institution and measures taken to curb it may be reviewed.

2. As per section 11.3 of the aforesaid regulations, the authorities/Management (Trust, Societies, etc.) of the institution, particularly the Head of the institution, shall be responsible to ensure that no incident of ragging takes place in the institution. In case any incident of ragging takes place, the Management/Head shall take prompt and appropriate action against the person(s) whose dereliction of duty lead to the incident. The authority designated to appoint the Head shall, in its turn, take prompt and appropriate action against the head.

3. All dental institutions should issue advertisements against ragging through signboards, pamphlets etc. before the commencement of academic year as well as during the midst of the session. You are also requested to issue booklets to all the students of your Institutions containing the details about what constitutes ragging, punishable ingredients of ragging, punishments and penalty for ragging, names and mobile numbers of the members of the Anti Ragging Squad, Anti Ragging Committee (Anti Ragging Helpline), Wardens, Deputy Wardens of Men's and Women's hostel.

4. All dental Institutions shall designate any of their faculty member(s) as "Counsellor" for fresher and senior students to co-ordinate the batches of students (Counselees) regularly about day-to-day problems and also to sensitize their role in curbing the menace of ragging.

5. You are further requested to obtain and file undertaking, on anti ragging, from all parents/guardians and students (1st year to final year) studying in BDS/MDS/PG Diploma/Para Dental Courses or any other course approved/recognised by DCI, online through www.antiragging.in / www.amanmovement.org.

6. Besides above, it is also pertinent to mentioned here that, as per **section 12.1** of subject regulations each and every institution shall submit its reports in prescribed format (Annexure-II) to the Secretary, Dental Council of India, Aiwan-E-Galib Marg, Kotla Road, New Delhi-110002, **by 30th April** of every year **in respect of the previous academic session**, indicating the requisite information against each column thereof, failing which the Dental Council of India, as per section 11.4 of Regulations on Curbing the Menace of Ragging in Dental Colleges, 2009, shall impose any one or any combination of the following penalties on it:-

- 11.4.1 To initiate the derecognition process against the institution under section 16A of the Dentists Act, 1948.
- 11.4.2 To reduce the admission capacity of the institution to the extent to which the Council deem fit.
- 11.4.3 To stop further admission in the institution till further orders.
- 11.4.4 To stop renewal of permission in respect of UG/PG Dental Courses.
- 11.4.6 To post the information regarding penalties so imposed on the concerned website of DCI for information of all concerned.




Further, it is also to inform you that the DCI has developed an online module to upload the requisite information / documents on DCI website to reduce the paper work and to scrutiny the above data efficiently, accordingly, it has been decided that the all the requisite information / documents required as per DCI Regulations on Curbing the Menace of Ragging in Dental Colleges, 2009, shall be uploaded on DCI website and any hard copy of information / documents received by Post or sent by E-mail shall NOT be considered by DCI.

8. In view of the above, I am directed to request you that the requisite information in the prescribed format (Annexure-II as prescribed in DCI Regulations) for the previous academic session 2018-2019 may kindly be uploaded on DCI website by 30.04.2019, positively, as the said information is required to be sent to the Monitoring Committee appointed by the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India. In case the information is not uploaded by 30.04.2019 on DCI website, the name of defaulting institution will be forwarded to the said Monitoring Committee for such appropriate action as may be deemed fit and proper by the said Hon'ble Monitoring Committee, and their names will also be uploaded on DCI Website.

9. This may kindly be treated as 'Most Urgent'.

10. The Dental Council of India ensures Zero Tolerance against ragging of any sort.

Sir/Madam,

I am directed to say that as per DCI Regulations on Curbing the Menace of Ragging in Dental Colleges, 2009, it is the responsibility of all the institution to ensure that no incident of ragging takes place in their dental institution and measures taken to curb it may be reviewed.

2. As per section 11.3 of the aforesaid regulations, the authorities/Management (Trust, Societies, etc.) of the institution, particularly the Head of the institution, shall be responsible to ensure that no incident of ragging takes place in the institution. In case any incident of ragging takes place, the Management/Head shall take prompt and appropriate action against the person(s) whose dereliction of duty lead to the incident. The authority designated to appoint the Head shall, in its turn, take prompt and appropriate action against the head.
3. All dental institutions should issue advertisements against ragging through signboards, pamphlets etc. before the commencement of academic year as well as during the midst of the session. You are also requested to issue booklets to all the students of your Institutions containing the details about what constitutes ragging, punishable ingredients of ragging, punishments and penalty for ragging, names and mobile numbers of the members of the Anti Ragging Squad, Anti Ragging Committee (Anti Ragging Helpline), Wardens, Deputy Wardens of Men's and Women's hostel.
4. All dental Institutions shall designate any of their faculty member(s) as "Counsellor" for fresher and senior students to co-ordinate the batches of students (Counselees) regularly about day-to-day problems and also to sensitize their role in curbing the menace of ragging.
5. You are further requested to obtain and file undertaking, on anti ragging, from all parents/guardians and students (1st year to final year) studying in BDS/MDS/PG Diploma/Para Dental Courses or any other course approved/recognised by DCI, online through www.antiragging.in / www.amanmovement.org.
6. Besides above, it is also pertinent to mentioned here that, as per section 12.1 of subject regulations, each and every institution shall submit its reports in prescribed format (Annexure-II) to the Secretary, Dental Council of India, Aiwan-E-Galib Marg, Kotta Road, New Delhi-110002, by 31st October of every year in respect of the previous academic session, indicating the requisite information against each column thereof, failing which the Dental Council of India, as per section 11.4 of Regulations on Curbing the Menace of Ragging in Dental Colleges, 2009, shall impose any one or any combination of the following penalties on it:-

- 11.4.1 To initiate the derecognition process against the institution under section 16A of the Dentists Act, 1948.
- 11.4.2 To reduce the admission capacity of the institution to the extent to which the Council deem fit.
- 11.4.3 To stop further admission in the institution till further orders.
- 11.4.4 To stop renewal of permission in respect of UG/PG Dental Courses.
- 11.4.6 To post the information regarding penalties so imposed on the concerned institution on the website of DCI for information of all concerned.



Further, it is also to inform you that the DCI has developed an online module to upload the requisite information / documents on DCI website to reduce the paper work and to scrutiny the above data efficiently, accordingly, the Executive Committee of the DCI in its meeting held on 13.10.2018 at New Delhi has decided that the all the requisite information / documents required as per DCI Regulations on Curbing the Menace of Ragging in Dental Colleges, 2009, shall be uploaded on DCI website and henceforth any hard copy of information /documents received by Post or sent by E-mail shall not be considered by DCI.

8. 
