Late. S. Kuldip Singh Gill was a self made and disciplined academician; who devoted his whole life for the cause education. His contributions to the society cannot be matched; he was instrumental in opening the first Public School, of Faridkot district under the name Dasmesh Public School. Later, extended his services in the medical education and contributed for the upliftment of Dasmesh Institute of Research & Dental Sciences in the year 1992, followed by Dasmesh College of Physiotherapy, Nursing and Pharmacy colleges at Faridkot. He played a major role in opening Dasmesh Public School, Kotkapura & Bargari, Dasmesh Global School, Kotkapura & Bargari.

He was not keeping good health since last six month to one year because of his spine problems, but suddenly on 10th Dec 2021 he said GOOD-BYE to everyone leaving all of us in TEARS behind. This institution is a living model of the rich legacy left behind by him. Board of Governors of Sangat Sahib Bhai Pheru Sikh Educational Society, Principal, Staff and Students of this great centre for education salute the immortal soul.

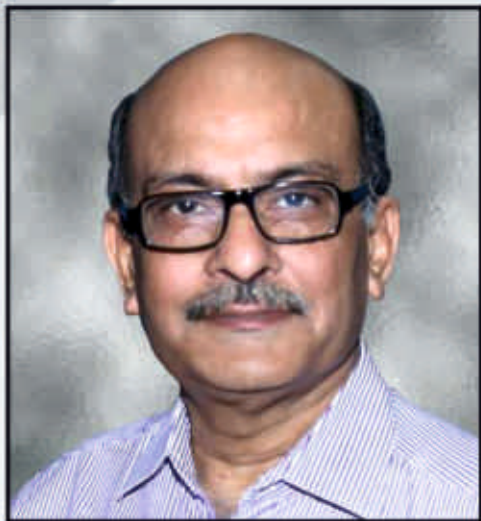

HISTORY RECAPTURED

Origin of SANGAT SAHIB BHAI PHERU SIKH EDUCATIONAL SOCIETY goes back to the days before partition of India and Pakistan. In those days SANGAT SAHIB BHAI PHERU SIKH EDUCATIONAL SOCIETY was a committee which first came up with SANGAT SAHIB BHAI PHERU KHALSA SIKH HIGH SCHOOL in a village named Bhai Pheru of Tehsil Chunia of Distt. Lahore.

SANGAT SAHIB BHAI PHERU SIKH EDUCATIONAL SOCIETY, having successfully running Khalsa School, and Dasmesh Public School, Faridkot, the society extended its services by opening Dasmesh Public School, Kotkapura (Estd.1981) and Dasmesh Model School Bargari (1988). Currently, all these schools are permanently affiliated with CBSE Delhi and enjoy the reputation of running one of finest Public Schools in Northern India. Encouraged by the success of Public Schools, the Society entered into the Professional Educational sphere. This region of Malwa once had no dental College & Hospital to treat the Dental ailments which are one of the prevalent medical problems in this area.

Society established Dasmesh Institute of Research and Dental Sciences & Hospital in year 1992 in the memory of Great Saint Soldier, Scholar par excellence Guru Gobind Singh Ji, under the chairmanship of distinguished political leader, philanthropist, educationist and social worker, S.Karnail Singh Doad Ex. MLA, Faridkot, Government of Punjab, with a vision to facilitate quality Dental health care & education of global standards. In the year 2015, because of his health related issues, S.Karnail Singh Doad nominated S.Gurdev Singh Brar IAS (Retd), as new president of Sangat Sahib Bhai Pheru Sikh Educational Society and he himself was raised to the post of chief Patron unanimously by all the members. S. Kuldip Singh Gill, Vice President was also raised to the post of Senior Vice President of the society. The contribution of S. Kuldip Singh Gill is imacable. His vast life long experience as an educationist and an administrator is playing a great role in the growth and development of this institution. The society is indebted for his contributions since its inception at Faridkot.

Dr.Gursevak Singh, Vice president, SANGAT SAHIB BHAI PHERU SIKH EDUCATIONAL SOCIETY & Director Dasmesh institute of research and dental sciences, has played a pivotal role in the starting of Dasmesh Institute of Research and Dental Sciences. His vision towards the quality academics is exemplary and his guidance further made this institution attain the current global standards. Infact, all the members of the Executive viz.-S. Jasbir Singh Sandhu, General Secretary; S. Amarjit Singh Doad, Joint Secretary; S. Swarnjit Singh Gill, Treasurer and Joint Director & all other members are selflessly and dedicatedly contributing in the yeomen service rendered towards the cause of education.

Their vision has shaped DIRDS into a premier Dental College of Northern India. Dasmesh Institute of Research & Dental Sciences had its own quota of teething troubles; in its first few years, the growth of the institution was comparatively slow, but having got over them all; it got recognized from DENTAL COUNCIL OF INDIA for 60 BDS seats in the year 2000. Later, by the incessant efforts of the dedicated members of Sangat Sahib Bhai Pheru Sikh Educational Society, the institution got recognized from DENTAL COUNCIL OF INDIA to enhance its BDS seats from 60 to 100. Further, Over the years, Management and staff have worked tirelessly to upgrade it to the level of Post Graduate Dental College with MDS Course in the year 2008. Currently we are having 18 post graduate seats per year in 7 different specialities. Currently all these seven Post graduate courses are recognized by DENTAL COUNCIL OF INDIA and the institution celebrated Its Silver Jubilee last year.

Determined hard work has made this college flourish into best private college and today it is one of the top most colleges of Punjab. From then on, progress of the college picked up the pace and now nestles in a state of art type magnificent four-storey, multi crore worth building that serves as a light-house amidst vast sea of dental-ailment prone five sandy districts of the region.

Over two decade-long life, with the commitment, dedication & vision of eminent board members of Sangat Sahib Bhai Pheru Sikh Educational Society have shaped DIRDS into a premier Dental College of Northern India. Currently, this service oriented Institution has best academic, Dental training, co-curricular and sports environment as a result whereof its scholars have been winning laurels in all the fields of their involvements like examinations, conferences & sports tournaments organized by the University and Dental Colleges located in & outside Punjab. Founder Principal of this institution was Dr.(Late) Manohar Singh, a renowned Orthodontist of his time. He was a very devoted and dedicated person and was instrumental in getting various approvals from competent authorities. In spite of early hiccups in getting approval and recognition from the competent authorities, Dr. (Late) Manohar Singh's untiring efforts are commendable. He remained Principal till 30.09.2003 thereafter, he served for couple of months after superannuation as Director (Academics). Dr.P. B Sood, Dr. Ila Shah served the institution as principal after Dr.Manohar Singh. The contribution of Dr. Y.P. Kansal to serve as officiating Principal from time to time remained commendable. Later Dr.Malkiat Singh, the first-ever Oral Surgeon of Punjab, took over as Principal and he served for couple of years. On 08.06.2006, Dr.Neeru Singh renowned pedodontist, took charge as Principal. She took the keen initiative for starting the MDS course in three specialities; Oral & Maxillofacial surgery, Pedodontics & Preventive Dentistry and Conservative & Endodontics and a year later in two more subjects, Prosthodontics and Periodontics. She also took active role in upgrading the intake capacity of BDS Course from 60 -100 seats. On 25.04.2011 Dr.S.P.S. Sodhi a well known Oral & Maxillofacial Surgeon, Implantologist and former Executive member of Dental Council of India, New Delhi, took charge as Principal. In his tenure, which is still going on; institution has marched on a fast track. Under his gifted guidance and leadership in 2012, the MDS

courses in three specialities Oral & Maxillofacial surgery, Pedodontics & Preventive Dentistry and Conservative & Endodontics got recognized and MDS courses in two more subjects Orthodontics and Oral medicine & Radiology got started. He was instrumental in getting the MDS recognized in all the seven specialities well in time and also getting the recognition for 100 seats in BDS Course. There is a marked improvement in the infrastructure viz. Addition of ultra modern, 550 capacity, with latest gadgets fitted, centrally A.C. auditorium; New Girls Hostel Mata Gujri, Bebe Nanki, Boys Hostel and residential complex; new Gymnasium and Sports Complex; has made the evening time of all the residents relaxing.

Over the years, our college has developed into a GROUP OF INSTITUTES as it has come up with training courses for B.Sc. & M.Sc (Nursing) in three specialities medical surgical nursing, obstetrics & gynaecological Nursing, Post Basic Nursing, & Paediatric Nursing. Later, GNM courses & ANM courses for nursing, Bachelors in Physiotherapy and Masters in Physiotherapy, Diploma in Dental Mechanics and Dental hygienists courses started within the campus. Another milestone was to start Dasmesh College of Pharmacy, which is being approved by All India Council of Technical Education, New Delhi and Punjab State Board of Technical and Industrial Training, Chandigarh. An Educational institute does not stand alone without its staff. Its well experienced, highly qualified and committed faculty makes this institute more unique. Presently, this group of highly motivated and hard working faculty is led by Dr. S.P.S. Sodhi, Principal and an eminent Oral & Maxillofacial Surgeon who has been consecutively awarded HealthCare Oscar Of India as the Most PROMISING DEAN OF THE YEAR by 'INDIAN HEALTH PROFESSIONAL AWARDS' (IHPA).

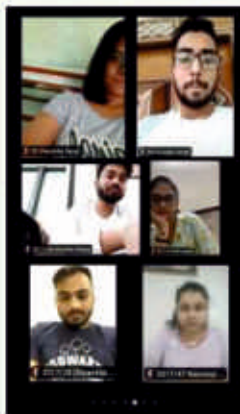
CONGRATULATIONS- MOMENT OF DIGNITY AND PRIDE

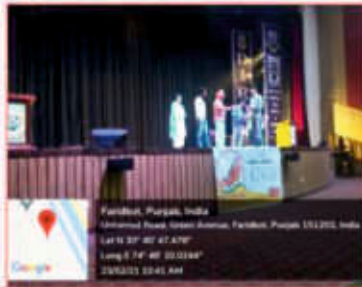
HONOURING THE COVID WARRIORS

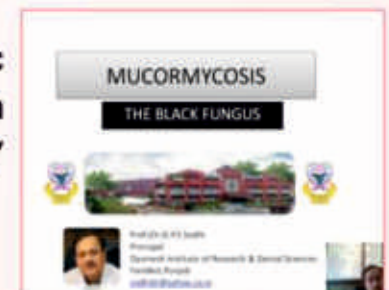
COVID 19- VACCINATION AWARENESS PROGRAMME

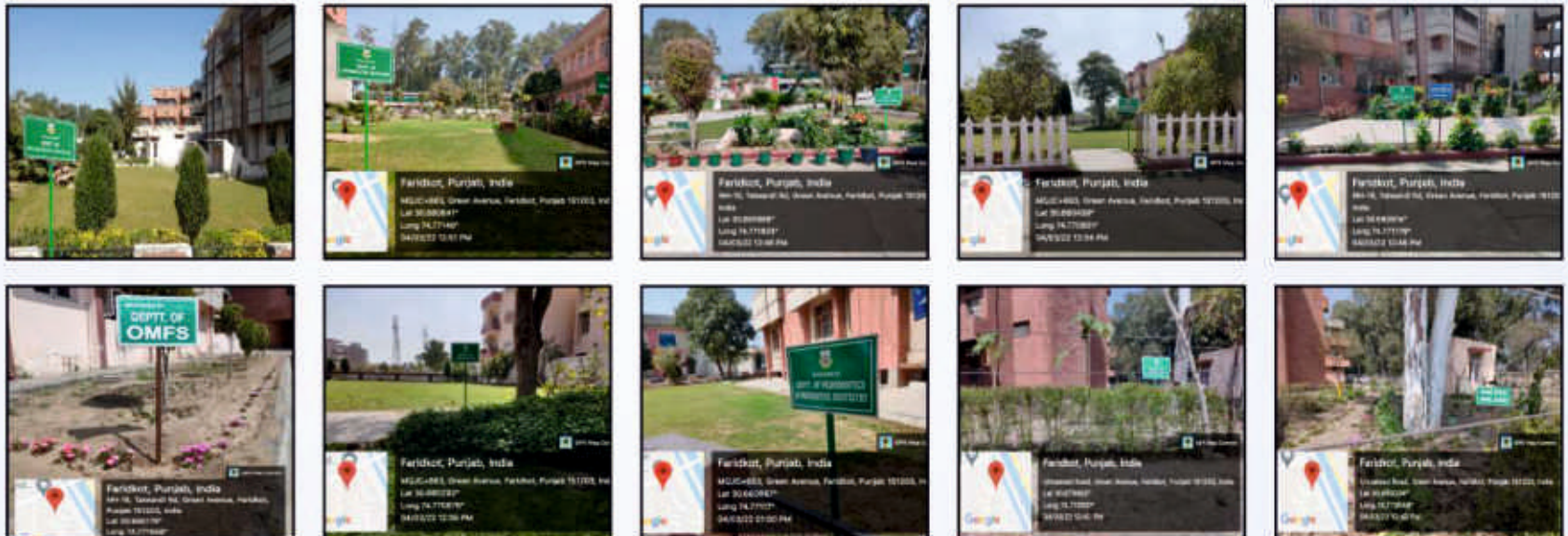
- **ORAL MAXILLOFACIAL DAY**

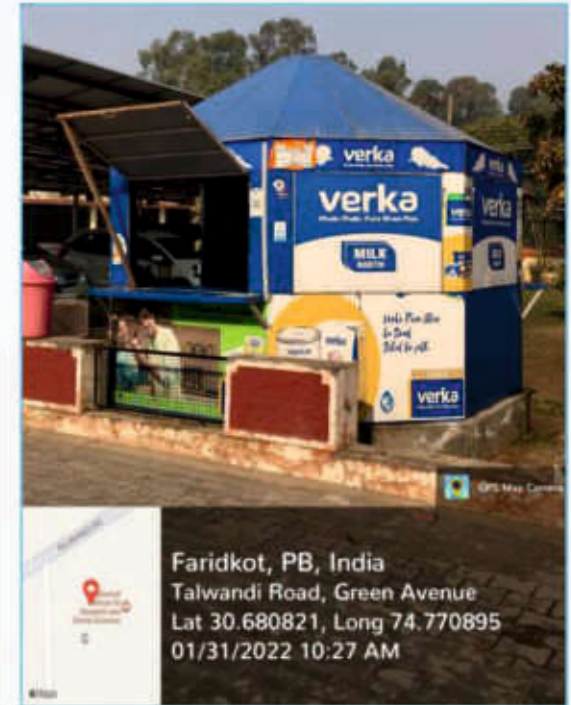
INAUGURATION OF FITNESS HUB

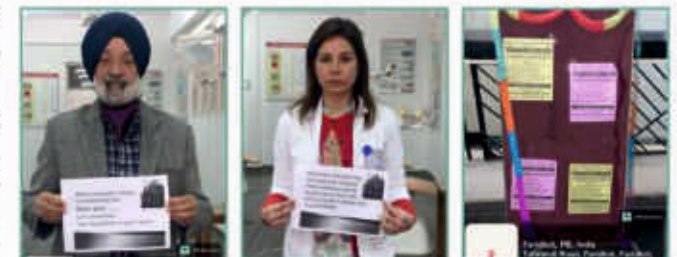
ORTHODONTIC SPECIALITY CAMPS

Department of Orthopaedics and Dentofacial Orthopaedics organized two speciality camps this year on 13. 11.2021 and 20.11.2021. A total of 381 patients were screened and diagnosed 109 patients having dental and skeletal malocclusions. They were recalled for follow up and various treatment modalities were explained to them for treatment of the malocclusions.



PEDODONTIC SPECIALITY CAMPS

Department of Pediatric & Preventive Dentistry conducted two specialty camps in our institution. First was held on the occasion of Pedodontist's day (15th Nov 2021) and second camp was organized on 27.12.201 & 28.12.2021 in remembrance of Shahidi Diwas of Chaar Sahibzaade ji. A total of 66 patients were screened in this camp. Scaling was performed for 28 patients. More than 35 teeth were restored, six teeth were extracted and root canal treatment was performed on nearly seven patients. More than 30 radiographs were taken. All the procedures were free of cost for all the patients. The validity of all cards made during the camp will be for a period of one month.



PROSTHODONTIC SPECIALITY CAMPS

Mega Free Dentures & Dental Ailments Camp was organized by the Department of Prosthodontics and Crown & Bridge on 26/07/2021, this camp was organized in memory of First Martyr of Sikh Panth Dhan Dhan Shri Guru Arjun Dev ji & all martyrs of Sikh Panth, 600 patients reported and got themselves enrolled for various dental treatments in various departments. & 160 patients reported to the Prostodontics department in this camp.



PERIODONTICS SPECIALITY CAMPS

Department of Periodontology conducted two specialty camps first on 18.01.21 and the next one on 08.11.2021, in these camps a total of 149 patients were screened, 74 patients were treated and 10 patients each were referred to the Depts of Prosthodontics & Oral Surgery for Dentures & extractions respectively. The validity of all cards made during this camp will be for a period of 3 months wherein the patients can avail of free hand scaling & 50% discount on all other periodontal procedures.

OVERVIEW OF THE DEPARTMENT

Oral medicine is a specialty within dentistry that focuses on the diagnosis and management of complex diagnostic and medical disorders affecting the mouth and jaws. Oral mucosal disease, salivary gland disorders, and facial pain syndromes are managed and we also provide dental care for patients with complicating medical disease. Department comprised of 2 sections- 1. Oral Medicine 2. Radiology. Patients visiting the department for various complaints are thoroughly examined following all standardized precautionary measures. A thorough medical history, dental history, surgical history, family history and personal history are recorded and systemic examination is done. Chair side investigations are performed for the better diagnosis of the diseases. Patients of red and white lesions, pigmented lesions, potentially malignant disorders, neuralgic or muscular pain etc. are managed in the department. Those requiring multidisciplinary management are referred to different departments. Radiology section comprised of 2 intraoral radiographic units, 1 extraoral unit, 1 OPG machine (Allengers) and 1 CBCT machine (Newtom Giano). Intraoral radiographs such as intraoral periapical radiographs (IOPAR), occlusal radiographs and extraoral radiographs such as panoramic radiographs (OPG), lateral cephalogram, TMJ radiographs etc. are done as and when required. Patients with extensive lesions such as cysts, tumors, inflammatory and infectious diseases, trauma etc. are subjected to CBCT.

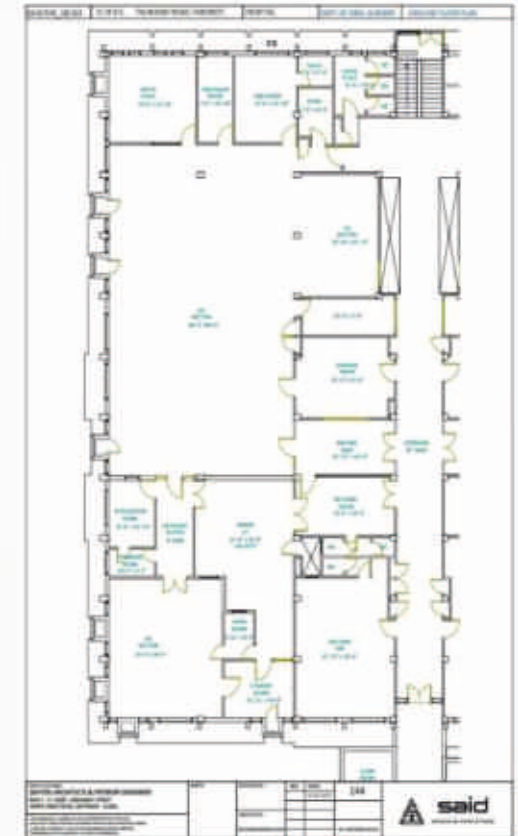
OVERVIEW OF THE DEPARTMENT

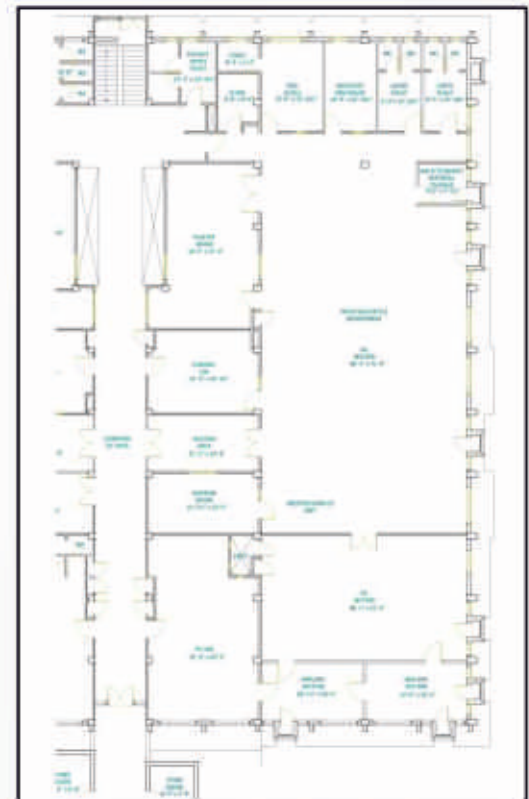
DEPARTMENT OF PROSTHODONTICS & CROWN & BRIDGE & ORAL IMPLANTOLOGY

Best practices

Patients with ill- fitting denture may seek either implant supported overdenture or full arch implant rehabilitation (FAIR Technique). Patients who have missing anatomical structure in maxillofacial region can receive maxillofacial prosthesis and regain the confidence.

The higher accuracy and quality of prosthesis is provided on patients demand with CAD CAM which also includes, zirconia crowns. Precision attachments are the other best part being practiced. These are alternative treatment plan to clasps in removable partial denture therapy, which gives both esthetic and functional outcome. Apart from above mentioned, various stents (surgical, nasal, trismus, radiation, medicament carrying stents, compression stents) are included among best practices.

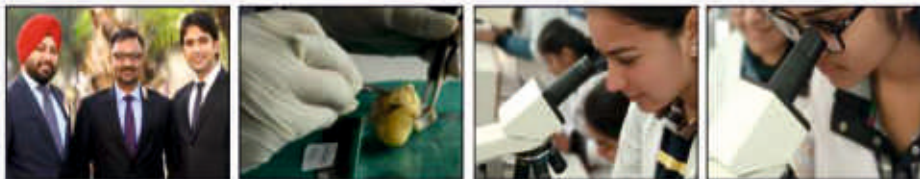

OVERVIEW OF THE DEPARTMENT

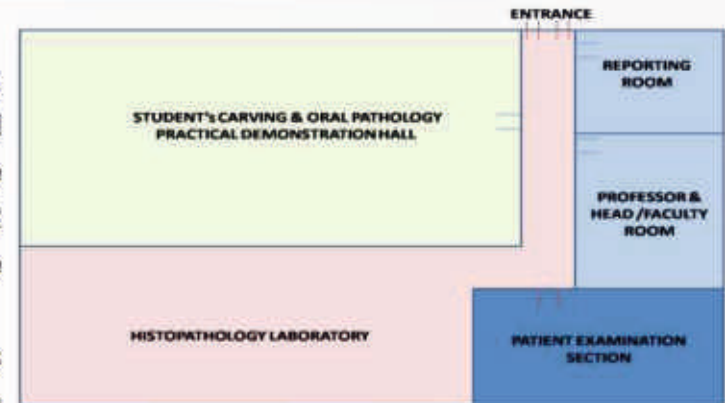

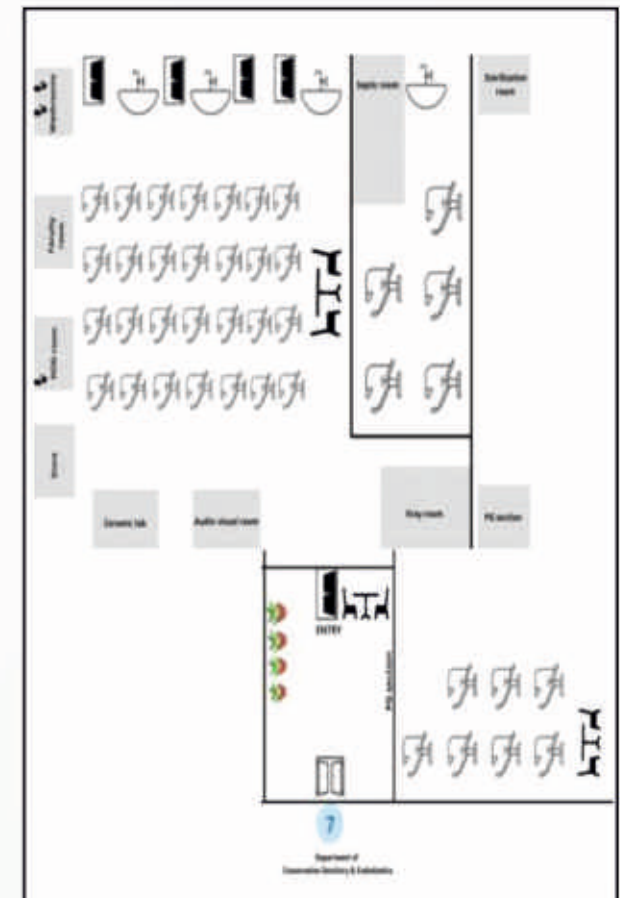
OVERVIEW OF THE DEPARTMENT

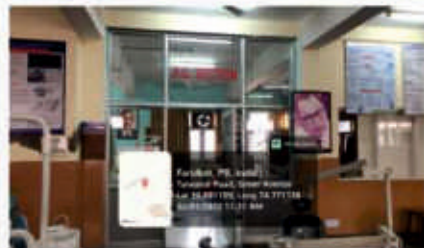
DEPARTMENT OF PERIODONTOLOGY & IMPLANTOLOGY

Dental Implants- An artificial tooth root made from titanium placed into the jaw to hold a tooth. The department has its own Dental implant surgical kit to place either Immediate implants or Delayed implants.

Recent innovation in dental technology are used in our department. We are placing conventional implants presently in the department (Noris Implant kit) as well as trephine implants (ARDS) and the implants with PRF.

Laser Dentistry- Shortly after their invention in the early 1960s, lasers were introduced in the field of periodontology to treat Periodontal (gum) disease and perform Esthetic oral surgeries. In the hands of a skilled, specially trained dentist, Lasers are safe and also pain-free, vibration-free and creates blood less operative field and saves ample amount of time. In this department, we are using Soft tissue Diode Laser of wavelength 980 nm with Fiberoptic Tip under Foot control in Continuous or Pulse mode, depending on the type of procedure.

LASER in our department has been used extensively for various procedures like frenectomy, gingivectomy, de-pigmentation, desensitization, and operculectomy.
