A HOLY MAN WITH EXEMPLARY VISION; THE MESSIAH OF SANGAT SAHIB BHAI PHERU SIKH EDUCATIONAL SOCIETY – LATE.S.KARNAIL SINGH DOAD



LATE.S.KARNAIL SINGH DOAD (28-03-1926 to 21-04-2019)

Late S.karnail Singh Doad was a distinguished advocate, political leader, philanthropist, educationist and social worker. He served as M.L.A, Faridkot and also was the founder secretary of Sangat Sahib Bhai Pheru Sikh Educational Society.

He was a revered man, who dreamt big and went after his dream with an iron will; his foray into education had just one aim — to enlighten young minds for the growth of society and nation. Under his visionary leadership later Sangat Sahib Bhai Pheru Sikh Educational Society started its educational services by starting khalsa school, the foundation of the school was laid by him with the sole aim of providing quality education to students coming from varied socio-economic and cultural backgrounds, inspired by the success of khalsa school, Sangat Sahib Bhai Pheru Sikh Educational Society extended its educational services by opening Dasmesh Public School, Faridkot; further Dasmesh Global School in kotkapura and Bargari and extended further into medical education by starting Dasmesh Institute of Research and Dental Sciences in the year 1992, followed by Dasmesh College of Physiotherapy, Nursing and Pharmacy colleges at Faridkot.

He was true "karmyogi"- in true sense messiah of Sangat Sahib Bhai Pheru Sikh Educational Society. He sacrificed his whole life for the cause of the education and for the poor and down trodden. When his health was not allowing him to work actively for the society, he just handed over his president ship to the most deserving senior vice president, S.Gurdev Singh Brar, I.A.S (Retd) as per protocol, a rarest example seen in today's protocol.

This institution is a living model of the rich legacy left behind by him. Board of governors of Sangat Sahib Bhai Pheru Sikh Educational Society, Principal, Staff and Students of this great centre for education salute the immortal soul.


Adoption of villages:

Regular Rural Oral Health Camp


Serving the community is an integral part of the DIRDS. This academic year DIRDS organized

25th S. Gurpreet Singh Doad memorial dental medical camp




